

## Carpal Tunnel Release Rehab Protocol

The surgeon must specify on the referral any specific recommendations or deviations outside this protocol.

-Pt may begin showering if wounds are healing. **No	-First MD post-op visit
immersion in water	-Sutures removed or suture tails removed
	-Remove post-op plaster splint
Post-op Plaster Splint:	
-Wear until 7-10 days post-op then remove	Clinical Implications:
	-Review home program
Clinical Implications:	-Begin scar management, including elastomer pad, as
-Remove post-op dressings	needed
-Provide wound care and edema reduction	-Strengthening, as needed
-Begin gentle digit and wrist ROM	-Desensitization, as needed
