GRH Foundation Scholarship Cycle

January – application window opens (watch for details on our [Facebook page](#)).

March 31 – application window closes.

April – Glencoe Regional Health Foundation Board of Directors reviews all applications and makes decisions regarding awards.

May – applicants are notified of the Board's decision.

July – first installment (half of total award—for fall semester tuition) is mailed to award recipients at their permanent address. Applicants are encouraged to bring or mail the check to their institution's financial aid office as soon as possible after receipt to ensure it can be applied to your student account in a timely manner.

November – second installment (half of total award – for spring semester) is mailed to award recipients at their permanent address.
