



## 2026 Scholarship Program Overview & Criteria

Glencoe Regional Health Foundation has been investing in local students since 2001 because we care about the future healthcare workforce for our community.

By submitting one application, applicants will be considered for any and all scholarships for which they are eligible. Note that an applicant may be awarded only one annual scholarship from us.

### Eligibility Criteria – **Sanken-Hatz Scholarship Program (multiple \$1,000 awards)**

- Applicant must be a current resident within or a graduate of high schools serving these communities within the Glencoe Regional Health service area, including:

- Applicant must be pursuing an eligible healthcare career, including:

Certified Nurse Practitioner	Pharmacist or Pharmacy Technician
Dentist (and Pre-Dentistry)	Physical Therapist or Physical
Dental Hygienist	Therapy Assistant
Medical, Surgical, or Medical	Physician (and Pre-Medicine)
Laboratory Technician	Physician Assistant
Mental or Behavioral Health	Radiologic or Ultrasound Technologist
Nuclear Medicine Technician	Registered Nurse or Licensed
Occupational, Speech, or	Practical Nurse
Respiratory Therapist	Others may be considered on a case-
Paramedic	by-case basis
- Applicant must have a minimum GPA of 3.0



## 2026 Scholarship Program Overview & Criteria

### Eligibility Criteria – **Carver Family Scholarship (one \$2,500 award)**

- Applicant must desire to work in a rural healthcare setting
- Applicant must have a permanent residential address within the Glencoe-Silver Lake (GSL) School District
- Applicant must be pursuing an eligible healthcare career, including any of those listed on page 1

### Eligibility Criteria – **Marilyn Ueland Memorial Scholarship (one \$2,500 award)**

- Applicant must have a permanent residential address within the Glencoe-Silver Lake (GSL), Lester Prairie, or Central Public (NYA) school districts
- Preference given to a current Glencoe Regional Health employee
- Preference given to a student working to elevate their healthcare career through additional education
- Applicant must be pursuing an eligible healthcare career, including any of those listed on page 1

### 2026 Scholarship Cycle

**January 1, 2026** – application window opens (watch for details on our [Facebook page](#)).

**February 28, 2026** – application window closes at midnight.

**April** – Glencoe Regional Health Foundation Board of Directors reviews all applications and makes decisions regarding awards.

**May** – applicants are notified of the Board's decision.

**July** – first installment (half of total award—for fall semester tuition) is mailed to award recipients at their permanent address. Applicants are encouraged to bring or mail the check to their institution's financial aid office as soon as possible to ensure it can be applied to your student account in a timely manner.

**November** – second installment (half of total award – for spring semester) is mailed to award recipients at their permanent address.
